VICE PRESIDENT - SENIOR CRICKET 2024/2025

Another season completed – they just seem to fly past.

Many of us just want to play cricket, but forget that there is a lot of work to before and after a game to make sure the competition runs smoothly. We are seeing too many forfeits and withdrawals. Club's need to better manage their players, and consider the opposition and umpires when organising teams each week.

Better understanding of player eligibility, through the season and finals, will help – we aim to make sure our rules are clear and simplified where possible. Information is provided to all clubs pre-season start, and throughout the season. Contact our administration team if any uncertainty.

It is a club responsibility to make sure players are correctly registered, and only the players who are participating in a game are listed on the team sheet. We will strengthen our compliance processes around player registration by requiring clubs to collect and maintain player identification documentation.

Managing a large competition is made easier if the background work is done in a timely manner.

E-Scoring will be mandatory in top grades this season – this will expand in future seasons.

We continue to be one of the few competitions in the north of Melbourne that offers 3 formats for senior cricket – two day matches, one day matches (Saturday and Sunday) and a T20 competition. We continue to attract clubs to our competitions as we offer varying formats. We again saw a shift away from the longer form of the game (6 two day competitions down from seven the previous season), and growth in the North and West of our regions.

We also continue to see some clubs closer to the CBD, and some smaller clubs struggling to maintain viability. We have seen a few of clubs merge over the last year or so, and the NWMCA will continue to support clubs to remain competitive and sustainable in any way we can. Grounds are at a premium in the inner suburbs. Clubs must work closely with their Council and neighbouring clubs to match teams to grounds.

Thank you to all of the NWMCA Board, but especially our administrators – without them the competition wouldn't run as smoothly as it does. They do a superb job! It gets harder and harder each year – we will look to expand our administration team and work closely with clubs – but that of course means additional costs.

Looking forward to season 2025-26 – it's not too far away. Wishing everyone a great season 2025-26.

JUNIOR PATHWAY

Representative cricket is a key component of the development pathway of young cricketers. We partner and work with Cricket Victoria, Premier, Sub-District Clubs and the Victorian Metropolitan Cricket Union (VMCU) to provide junior players development and pathway opportunities.

Each year, the NWMCA enters representative junior boys teams in the VMCU Junior Carnival. At the 2025 VMCU Carnival, we entered 7 teams in the various Shields and Cups. Each season we look to improve our North West representative program and provide a positive experience for all participants. Congratulations to our Under 16 Keith McKay Cup team on reaching the semifinal. A special mention to the following players Billy Thomas ranked 4th highest run scorer with 230 runs at 37.67 which included two 50s and a high score (HS) of 85*. Harry Marr was the 9th highest run scorer with 156 runs at 22.29 including on 50 and a highest core of 54. Anhad bir Singh on taking 18 wickets at an average of 10.61 ranked the 2nd highest bowler. Best bowling performance 5/19. Harry Marr was the 4th ranked bowler taking 14 wickets at an average of 12.29 including best bowling (BB) 5/22.

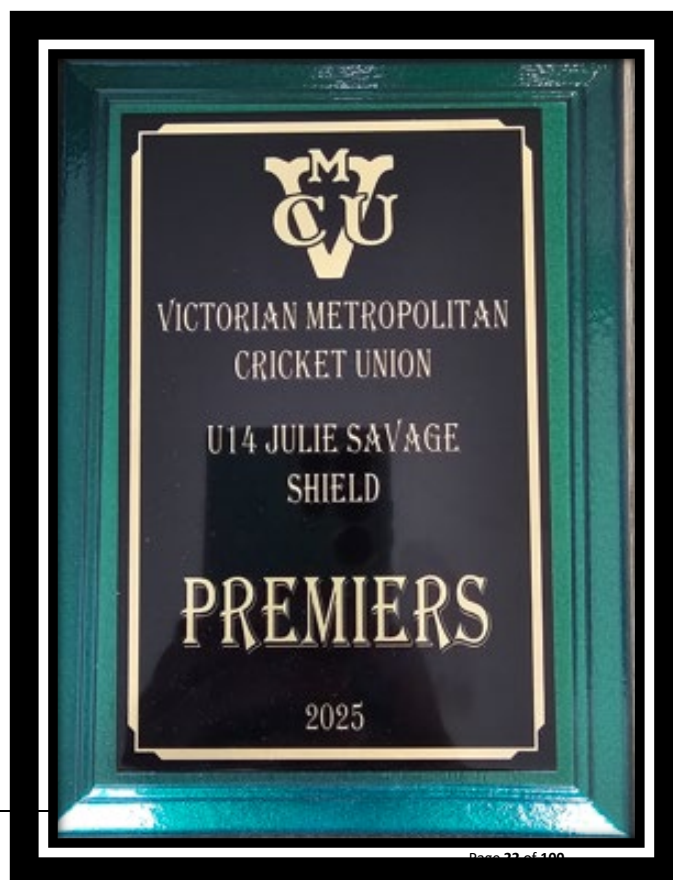

UMPIRING REPORT 2024/2025

Changes to Laws of Cricket

There were no changes to the MCC's Laws of Cricket. The existing Laws (2017 Code 3rd Edition – 2022), will also remain current for next season – 2025-26

Changes to NWMCA Rules

Majority of rule changes for season 24-25 revolved around processes and procedures

Changes / improvements to process to change fixtures after publication meant reduced number of errors in umpire allocations, reducing costs to association.

Changes to the process of notifying and management of forfeits / walkovers received meant umpires were generally able to be re-allocated to other games, meaning improvements to effective use of umpires.

Use of WhatsApp to communicate directly with umpires in relation to changes, where matches were to be cancelled, etc provided very successful. We look to improve on umpire management in this regard going forward.

Cricket Victoria has initiated steps to address umpire availability.

Officials HQ

With the release of OfficialsHQ 2.0, we were able to create and implement Umpires Reports and Captains Reports on Umpires across all sections.

We were able to get all umpires (Seniors and Junior panel members registered on OfficialsHQ.

We need to get all umpires better skilled in putting their availability (leave) in OfficialsHQ.

We also need to ensure:

- Umpires accept or reject allocations as appropriate.
- Umpires complete reports on all matches in which they officiate (Seniors and Juniors)
- Captains (or coaches/team managers for juniors) complete all reports where an independent umpire is allocated.
- Votes are entered for all awards (Seniors and Juniors) where appropriate.
-

Seniors:

With Darrell Holt and Eric Kelly both stepping away from umpire management roles they had performed effectively for many years, we trialled a panel approach to allocation of umpires to Senior Men/Mixed Saturday and Sunday competitions.

Vanessa Brooker superbly managed the allocation of umpires in the OfficialsHQ system and used WhatsApp to advise umpires of allocations being released. Vanessa also made changes as required, effectively and efficiently communicating changes to clubs and umpires. This reduces the cost of payments to umpires where clubs forfeit,

and umpires still require payment, for example, or allocation errors are made. Frustrations are reduced for clubs who believe they have an umpire allocated, but an umpire does not arrive.

Juniors:

An active recruitment program, managed by Vanessa Brooker was extremely successful. With over 140 umpires on the list, many first time umpires, getting them prepared for the season was a challenge – again use of communication tools such as WhatsApp chat groups helped in this regard.

CV introduced a two part umpire accreditation course, with the first part being online

Thanks to Darrell Holt and Eric Kelly in initiating and accreditation of all new junior umpires to basic umpiring skills and on-field techniques, before the junior season commenced.

Some junior umpires completed the second part of the CV accreditation course, being a face to face session arranged by CV

A huge thank you to Marcus Lee for taking on the difficult task of allocating junior umpires to all junior matches. With junior games 5 days a week, it is never ending and frustrating task – Marcus battled on and found the time in between umpiring many matches of his own for our association and other associations / leagues, working with Vanessa Brooker to plug the junior umpire allocations into Officials HQ, and then use communication tools to let umpires know when allocations have been completed (reliance on Officials HQ on it's own is a risk).

We made a few mistakes, and we will improve going forward, as we take feedback from clubs on board, and look to move to more electronic payment of junior umpires.

Women's Social T/20 Grades

Umpires were provided, when possible, to Women's Social T/20 Grades. Both senior and junior panel umpires were appointed to Women's matches. Again thanks to Marcus and Vanessa for managing these allocations

Under Age Umpire Award - Terry Scott Medal

Damon Sykes, was awarded the Terry Scott Medal, awarded to the best Under Age Grades umpire for 2024/25.

- First Year Umpire – high average rating from Clubs.
- Umpired VMCU matches (Very good “reports”)
- Moved through grades up to Under 16's Friday Nights
- Umpired Under 16 (1) Friday Grade Grand Final.

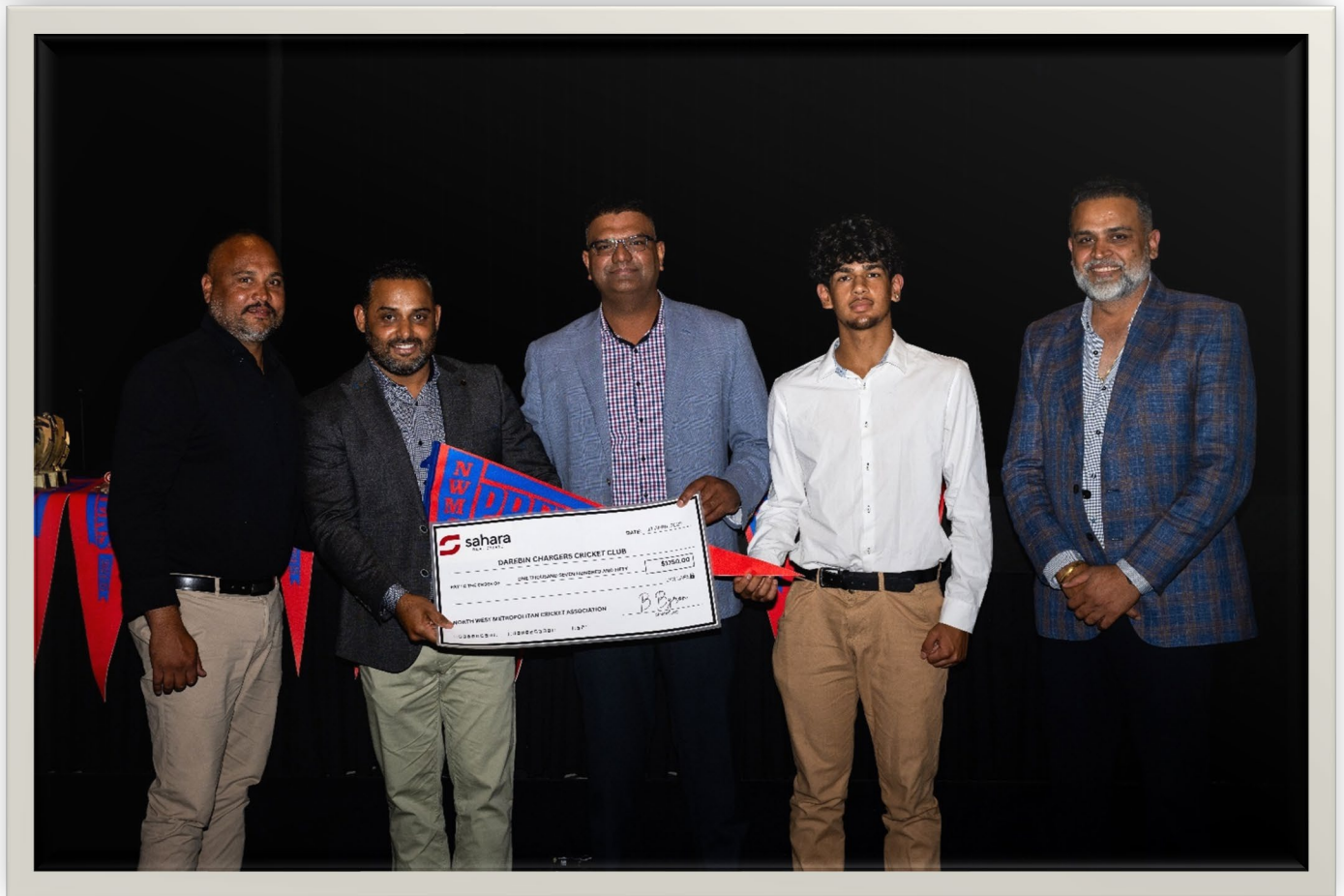
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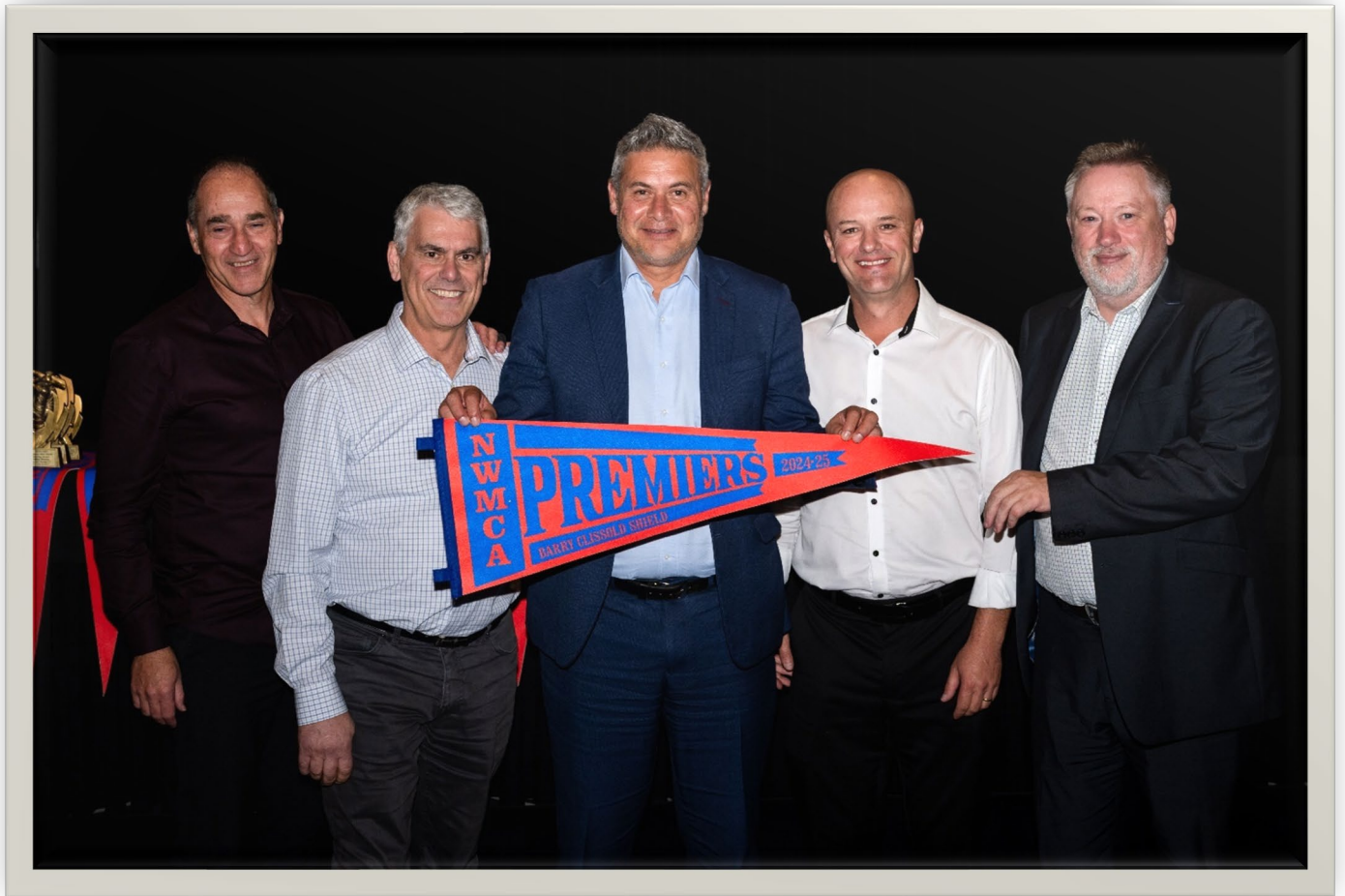

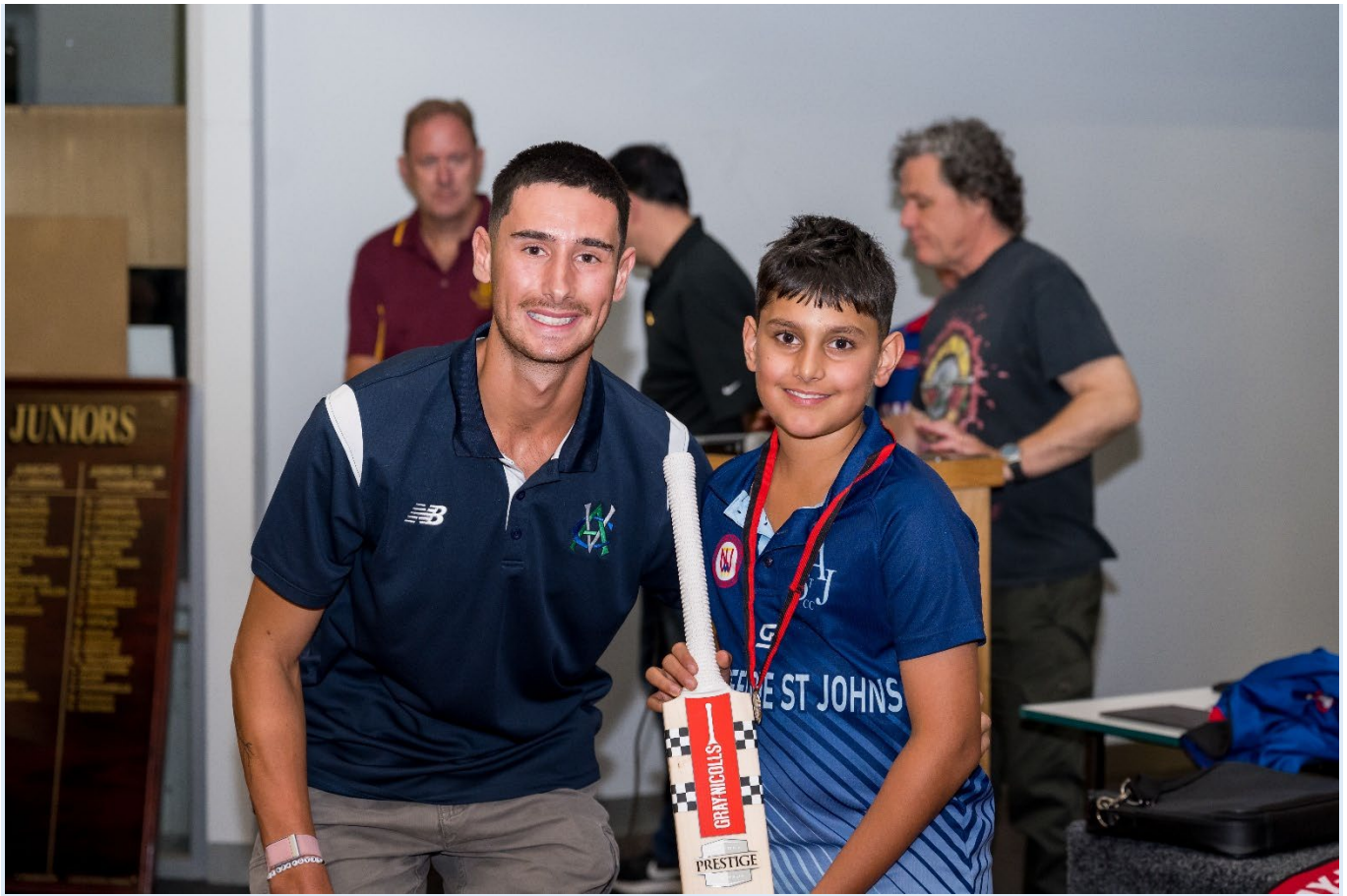
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TREASURER'S REPORT 2024-25

Treasurer's Report

It is with much pleasure that I submit the Financial Report for Season 2024-2025, inclusive of the Independent Auditor's Report for the year ended 30 June 2024.

At the time of publishing, the Independent Auditor is scheduled to undertake the financial audit for the year ended 30 June 2025 on 17 July 2025, with his report expected shortly thereafter. That report will be made available to all clubs upon receipt and will be published with the Annual Report for Season 2025-2026.

I extend my sincere thanks to all club officials for their continued support and collaboration throughout the season to ensure the effective financial performance of your Association.

I am pleased to advise your Association achieved a Net Surplus of \$21,086.29 versus a planned Net Surplus of \$6,000.00. This result was due on the one part to revenue from fines and administrative services provided to clubs, both being income your Association does not plan for nor seeks to rely upon. On the second part, the result was due to lower than budgeted administration costs.

The entire cost base of your Association continues to experience price increases consistent with the broader economy. As per prior year practice, significant cash reserves have been committed to softening as much as possible the impact of continued price increases, which is best reflected by the amount of prepaid expenses and merchandising stock on hand as at 30 June 2025.

Importantly, your Association continues to maintain an appropriate level of liquidity as reflected by the working capital elements as detailed in the Statement of Financial Position.

Finally, you will note that your Association continues to be in a sound financial position, and, your Board continues to work tirelessly at providing fiscal prudence across all of its activities, as well as identifying value-add services for clubs in the future. To this final point, I extend my sincere thanks to your Association's administrators for their focus, attention to detail, commitment to all stakeholders, diligence and wise counsel.
